


Therapies that cure RESTORE submitted proposal for stage 2

The consortium "RESTORE Health by Advanced Therapies" submitted the proposal for the Large Scale Research Initiative preparatory action phase on September 18, 2018. RESTORE is supported by more than 250 stakeholders from science, industry, non-profit organizations and patient representatives throughout Europe and beyond (USA, Asia), underlining the importance of Advanced Therapies for the scientific and public society.

The European Commission (EC) are creating Large Scale Research Initiative to enable new approaches for cooperative research in Europe. They are science and technology-driven, large-cale multidisciplinary re-search initiatives. The aim is to attract the best scientists and to establish long-term centers of excellence in Europe leading worldwide in their field.
